The payment of a deposit represents acceptance by the tour member(s) of this Liability, Assumption of Risks and Binding Agreement.

Wanderlust Adventures Inc., its employees, shareholders, subsidiaries, affiliates, officers, directors and successors, (collectively Wanderlust Adventures) does not own or operate any entity that provides, or is to provide, goods or services for your trip including, for example, lodging facilities, airlines and transportation companies, food service providers, equipment suppliers, local ground handlers, naturalists and certain guides, etc. As a result, Wanderlust Adventures is not liable for any negligent or willful act or failure to act of any such person, or of any other third party.

Wanderlust Adventures is not liable for any direct, indirect, consequential, or incidental damage, injury, death, loss, accident, delay, inconvenience or irregularity of any kind that may be occasioned by reason of any act or omission beyond its control, including without limitation any willful or negligent act, failure to act, breach of contract or violation of local law or regulation of any third party such as an airline, train, hotel, bus, taxi, van, yacht or vessel, local ground handler or guide, whether or not it uses the Wanderlust Adventures name, financial default or insolvency of any supplier that is, to, or does supply any goods or services for this trip. Wanderlust Adventures is not responsible for any loss, injury, death or inconvenience due to delay or change in schedule, overbooking of accommodation, default of any third party, attacks by or bites from wild or domestic animals, pests or insects, epidemics or the threat thereof, sickness, the lack of appropriate medical care and/or evacuation to same, if necessary, weather, strikes, acts of God or government, lost or misplaced luggage, acts of terrorism or the threat thereof, force majeure, war, quarantine, criminal activity, or any other cause beyond its control.

I am voluntarily participating in this trip (or any trip to which I may subsequently transfer) with the knowledge of the numerous risks and dangers involved including but not limited to negligence on the part of Wanderlust Adventures (for example, negligence in the conduct or arrangement of the trip in any respect from inception to completion, negligence with regard to selection of suppliers, locations and otherwise). I acknowledge that the enjoyment and excitement of adventure travel, such as this trip, is derived in part from the inherent risks incurred by travel and activity beyond the accepted safety of life at home or work and that these inherent risks contribute to such enjoyment and excitement, and are a reason for my participation. I agree to be responsible for my own welfare and accept any and all risks of delay, unanticipated events, inconvenience, illness, injury, emotional trauma or death.

Wanderlust Adventures reserves the right to refuse a trip participant, or remove, at his or her own expense and without any refund, from a trip, any person it judges to be incapable of meeting the rigors and requirements of participating in the activities, or who it determines detracts from the enjoyment of the trip by others. I agree to follow all written and verbal rules of safety or otherwise presented to me by Wanderlust Adventures, the trip leaders, or the local ground handler. Wanderlust Adventures reserves the right to make route, hotel, itinerary, leader changes and trip modifications as required or desirable to improve the trip quality and/or to accommodate the comfort and well-being of guests.

BINDING ARBITRATION Any dispute concerning, relating, or referring to this contract, brochures, web information, or any other literature concerning my trip, or the trip itself, shall be resolved

exclusively by binding arbitration in Ontario, according to the then existing commercial rules of the Canadian law. Such proceedings will be governed by substantive (but not procedural) Ontario law excluding any application. The arbitrator and not any federal, provincial, or local court or agency shall have exclusive authority to resolve any dispute relating to the interpretation, applicability, enforceability or formation of this contract, including but not limited to any claim that all or any part of this contract is void or voidable.

MISCELLANEOUS MATTERS Wanderlust Adventures shall not be liable for (a) expenses such as additional hotel nights, transportation and meals not specified in the individual trip itineraries, but which may be required to get to or from a trip start or end; (b) expenses due to the delay of a trip for any reason (e.g., bad weather, trail conditions, landslides, flooding, sickness, etc.); (c) expenses incurred in recovering luggage lost by airlines, belongings left behind on a trip, or in shipping purchases or other goods home from abroad.

Wanderlust Adventures reserves the right to take photographic or film records of any of our trips, and may use any such records for promotional and/or commercial purposes without payment.

DECLARATION I understand this is a legally binding and enforceable contract and sign it of my own free will. I agree that if any portion of this agreement is found to be void or unenforceable, the remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect. I have carefully read and fully understand the contents and legal ramifications of this agreement as well as all the conditions as stated under the heading "General Conditions" of this document, especially noting those regarding cancellation and refund policies, limitations of liability, and responsibility borne by trip participants. General Trip Conditions

Reservations & Deposits

Early reservations are recommended, since group sizes are limited and airlines often sell out of their best fares many months in advance. For immediate confirmation on a trip, you can call us at (905) 783 3384 and charge the initial deposit to your Visa, MasterCard, or American Express credit card, or mail the enclosed Application Form along with a check. Each participant must submit a separate signed trip booking form prior to departure.

Upon receiving your deposit we will send you a confirmation letter, an invoice, travel insurance application if opted to purchase with Wanderlust, and a pre-departure general information with clothing and equipment list and general information needed to prepare for your trip. Joining instructions, and final trip documents will be sent about 2-3 weeks prior to departure.

* Payment schedules for private departures, extensions, and certain Special Events vary. These exceptions are clearly indicated in the detailed trip pages in the dossiers or the web site.

Prices are quoted in CAD dollars (and/or US Dollars) and all payments must be made by check or credit card. Payments submitted less than 15 days prior to departure must be only by credit card or bank Manager's check.

All credit card payments for Wanderlust Adventures trips will be processed/charged by its host agency/associate office, **Tourcan Vacations Inc, Toronto**. Your credit card statements will reflect payments as charged by **Tourcan Vacations Inc**.

All check payments should also be written in favour of "**Tourcan Vacations Inc**" clearly marking as "Payment for Wanderlust Adventures Trip to.....(Trip name/Dates)".

Pricing

To offer the lowest possible price, all of our tours are priced according to the number of full-price participants on the trip. Wanderlust Adventures staff, trip leaders, accompanying spouses, physicians (if any), or guests of Wanderlust Adventures (travel writers, photographers, leaders-in-training) are not included in the tier pricing count.

Prices are per person and Land only, unless otherwise noted as flights included. A full list of Included and Not Included Trip Costs are noted in the Detailed Itinerary, Dates, Prices & Info sections of the trip pages.

Prices listed in the web and trip dossiers are subject to change because the trip dates and prices have often been published more than a year in advance. Between that time and the time of the trip's actual departure, we are occasionally faced with exceptional cost increases or currency fluctuations that we cannot absorb. We do everything we can to keep our prices the same as published. Please note that for trips in certain areas we operate such as in Asia, South America and Africa, prices are seasonal.

Single & Solo Traveler Supplements

Accommodations are based on double occupancy. A single/solo supplement is paid by participants who specifically request single accommodations, subject to availability. If you are traveling alone and wish to share accommodations, we will try to match you with a roommate. However, if a roommate is not available, the forced single supplement will be charged.

Cancellations and Refunds

If it becomes necessary for you to cancel your trip, the following fees will apply, computed as of the date of receipt of written cancellation notice, which can be sent by email or standard mail.

Cancellation Fee Schedule*

Up to 90 days prior to departure:	Deposit
89-45 days prior to departure:	25% of trip cost
44-30 days prior to departure:	50% of trip cost
29 days or less:	100% of trip cost

* Cancellation and transfer schedules for certain group trips, as well as private departures, extensions, and Special Events are often more strict. These exceptions are clearly indicated in the detailed itineraries for each of these trips.

Rates are based on group participation and no partial refunds will be given for unused trip arrangements for any reason whatsoever. Once you have been confirmed on a trip that requires a medical certificate signed by a doctor, normal cancellation penalties apply if your doctor does not sign the certificate. We highly recommend that all clients purchase trip cancellation insurance.

Transfer a Trip Enrolment

You may transfer to another trip without penalty by notifying us of your wish to transfer 91 days or more prior to departure. After that time, you are subject to the cancellation fees outlined above. Special Events, certain group departures and private trips are subject to special terms outlined in the detailed itinerary.

Cancelled Trips

Wanderlust Adventures Inc. reserves the right to cancel any trip prior to departure for any reason whatsoever, including insufficient sign-up or logistical problems that may impede trip operations. The refund of all payments received shall release Wanderlust Adventures, Inc. from any further liability. A trip with insufficient sign-up would normally be cancelled a minimum of 60 days prior to departure.

Wanderlust Adventures Inc., must normally make substantial payments to its suppliers (hotels, transportation companies, etc.) far in advance of the scheduled departure date. If a trip is cancelled due to force majeure (acts of God, war, labor strikes, earthquake, flooding, etc.), Wanderlust Adventures Inc., will promptly refund the portion of the trip cost not already advanced to suppliers and use its best efforts to recover and refund the balance as promptly as possible. However, Wanderlust Adventures Inc., does not guarantee recovery of any or all of the advance payments made, and our use of best efforts to recover these payments will not include the institution of any legal proceedings in foreign jurisdictions.

Wanderlust Adventures Inc., is not responsible for expenses incurred by trip members in preparing for a cancelled trip (e.g., non-refundable advance purchase air tickets, visa fees, inoculations, equipment, etc.) or for any additional arrangements should the trip member have embarked prior to the scheduled group departure date.

Trip Member's Responsibility

Trip members have the responsibility to select a trip appropriate to their abilities and interests. In order to assist you, we grade each trip with a Trip Rating. We are also happy to discuss the trip with you, as well as provide you with names of past participants who can discuss their experience with you. Trip members must be in sufficient good health to undertake the trip. Trip members are responsible for preparing for the trip by studying the itinerary and pre-departure information sent by Wanderlust Adventures Inc. and for bringing the appropriate clothing and equipment as advised therein.
